Interstate 95 From the north: Connect to I-91 North in New Haven; take Exit 3 (Trumbull Street) and follow directions below for I-91. From the south:

Connect to I-91 North in New Haven (left exit); take Exit 3 (Trumbull Street) and follow directions below for I-91.

Interstate 91 From the north or south: Take Exit 3 (Trumbull Street). Stay in the middle lane and continue straight onto Trumbull Street to the fifth traffic light.

Turn left onto Prospect Street and continue for one block. Prospect Street becomes College Street at this point. (*) Continue for 1 block to Harkness Hall, adjacent to Sprague Hall. Harkness Hall's address is 100 Wall Street, but is also accessible from College Street on the right hand side, via the Cross Campus walkway. If you cross Elm Street, you've passed it. Look for the Augustine Fellowship Life Saver Logos on the sidewalk.

Route 15 (Wilbur Cross/Merritt Parkways) From the north: Take Exit 61. Drive south on Whitney Avenue for approximately five miles. Turn right on Sachem Street at the Peabody Museum traffic light. Continue to next traffic light and turn left onto Prospect Street. At the second traffic light, Prospect Street becomes College Street. *See the balance of the directions above. From the south: Take Exit 57. Drive east on Route 34 (Derby Avenue) for approximately five miles past the Yale Athletic Fields. Turn left onto Route 10 North, Ella T. Grasso Boulevard. Proceed to the fifth traffic light and turn right onto Whalley Avenue. Whalley becomes Broadway in 1 mile, and Broadway becomes Elm Street in another .2 miles. Continue on Elm for 2 blocks, turn left onto College Street. Harkness Hall is a half block up on the left hand side. See I-91 directions above, for additional info. in locating Harkness Hall.

Route 34 From the west: Follow directions from Route 34 above.

Coming by Plane Tweed New Haven Airport is 10 minutes from the Yale campus by car or taxi.

Coming by Train At the New Haven railroad station, take a taxi. The taxi stand is located in front of Union Station.

Parking On-street metered parking is available on most streets. FREE parking is available in LOT 51; entrance is located off of Temple Street, between Elm and Wall Street. Walk between the School of Music Buildings, then across College Street, to Harkness Hall.

Campus Information Available at the Yale Visitor's Center (203-432-2300), located at 149 Elm Street; just around the corner from Harkness Hall.
